All of us need to establish good security practice but the addition of extra management and administration staff is often overwhelming and un-affordable.

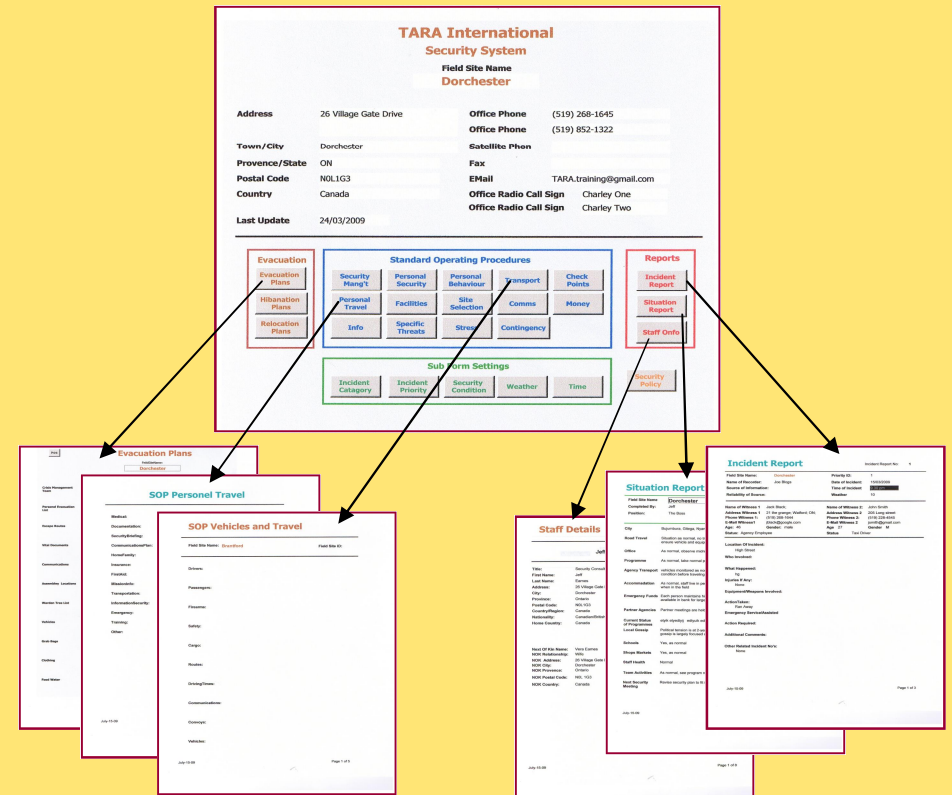
To this end we have developed a system which will enable all agencies, the largest to the smallest, to have up to date and comprehensive security procedures and documentation in place.

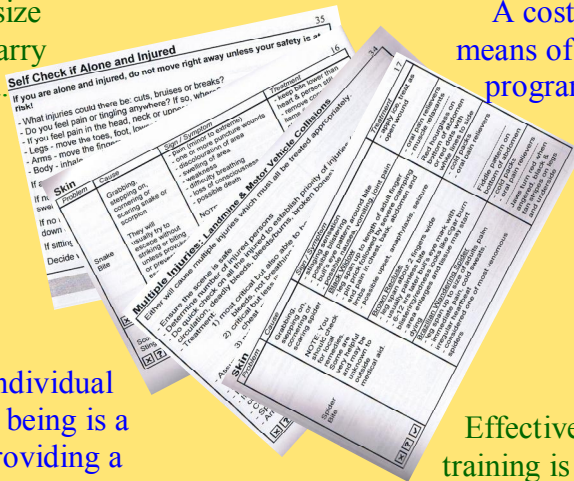
